Question:

DAY 2

Question:

DAY 3

Question:

Jesus chose regular people (fishermen and even a tax collector) to follow Him. What does that tell you about the kind of people Jesus wants on His team?

DAY 4

Question:

Jesus asked His disciples to help Him tell others about God. Who is someone in your life you can tell about Jesus?

DAY 5

Question:

Jesus told His disciples to follow Him. How can we follow Jesus today?
